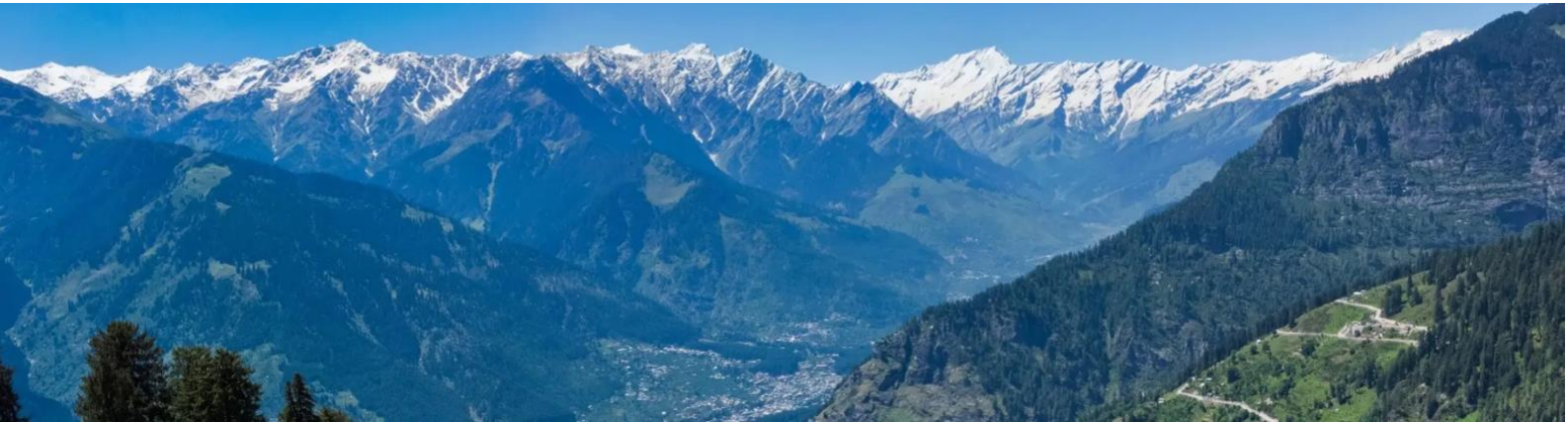


Day 1- Chandigarh – Manali

Pick up from Chandigarh Airport / Railway Station, Start your road trip from Chandigarh to Manali. Driving from Chandigarh to Manali via Kullu is a scenic and picturesque journey. The approximate distance between Chandigarh and Manali is around 310 kilometres, and the journey takes about 8-9 hours by road, depending on traffic and road conditions. The route passes through picturesque landscapes with lush greenery.

As you approach Kullu, consider making a stop to explore this beautiful valley. Visit the Kullu Shawl Factory to see the traditional craftsmanship. Stop for lunch at a restaurant in Kullu or a nearby town. Continue your journey from Kullu to Manali. The road to Manali offers breath-taking views of the Beas River and surrounding mountains. Enjoy the scenic drive along the Beas River, passing through picturesque villages and apple orchards. Reach Manali and check into your hotel. Freshen up and relax after the drive.

Enjoy dinner at your hotel with panoramic views of Manali night lights.



Day 2- Manali Local Sightseeing : Exploring the Gem of Himachal Pradesh

Hadimba Devi Temple - Begin your day by visiting the iconic Hadimba Devi Temple. Explore the pagoda-style wooden temple dedicated to Goddess Hadimba.

Manu Temple (Its 1 km track from Club House Parking) - Head to the Manu Temple, dedicated to the sage Manu. Admire the serene surroundings and the architectural beauty.

Explore the eateries in Old Manali for a delightful lunch.

Tibetan Monastery - Visit the Tibetan Monastery in Manali. Explore the peaceful surroundings and the monastery's architecture.

Vashisht Hot Water Springs - Relax at the Vashisht Hot Water Springs. Enjoy a therapeutic soak in the natural hot springs.

Evening free for shopping at the Manali streets.

Conclude your day with a delightful dinner.

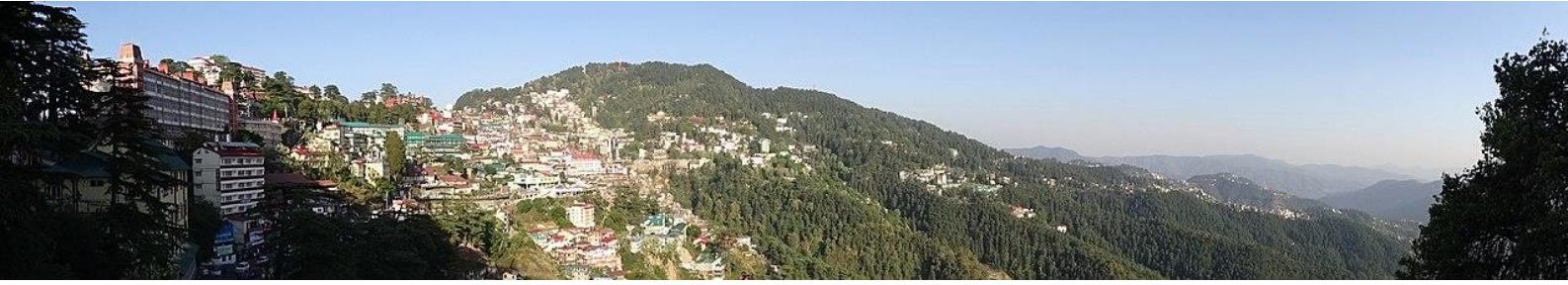


Day 3- Manali – Solang Valley – Manali :

Day 4- Manali – Shimla(245 KM – 6 – 7 Hours)

Traveling from Manali to Shimla offers a picturesque journey through the Himalayan region of Himachal Pradesh. The distance between Manali and Shimla is approximately 250 kilometres, and the journey takes around 7-8 hours by road.

Begin your journey from Manali and head towards Mandi. Enjoy the scenic drive through the mountainous terrain. Consider making a brief stop in Mandi, known for its temples and the scenic Prashar Lake. The road to Shimla offers beautiful views of valleys and forests.
